Problema





- 1 a si 1 b Aplicati produsul dezinfectant in palma acoperind toata suprafata
- 2 Frecati mainile palma peste palma
- 3 Palma dreapta peste cea stanga cu impletirea degetelor si vice versa
- 4 Palma peste palma cu degetele impletite
- 5 Dosul degetelor pe palma opusa cu degetele impreunate.
- 6 Frecari rotative cu degetul mare stang prins in palma dreapta si vice versa.
- 7 Frecari rotative intr-un sens si celalalt cu degetele impreunate ale mainii dreapte, pe palma stanga si vice versa
- 8 Odata uscate, mainile sunt dezinfectate.

How to Handwash?

WASH HANDS WHEN VISIBLY SOILED! OTHERWISE, USE HANDRUB

 Duration of the entire procedure: 40-60 seconds




0 Wet hands with water;



1 Apply enough soap to cover all hand surfaces;




2 Rub hands palm to palm;



3 Right palm over left dorsum with interlaced fingers and vice versa;



4 Palm to palm with fingers interlaced;



5 Backs of fingers to opposing palms with fingers interlocked;



6 Rotational rubbing of left thumb clasped in right palm and vice versa;




7 Rotational rubbing, backwards and forwards with clasped fingers of right hand in left palm and vice versa;



8 Rinse hands with water;



9 Dry hands thoroughly with a single use towel;



10 Use towel to turn off faucet;



11 Your hands are now safe.



- 0 Udati mainile cu apa.
- 1 Aplicati sapun suficient pentru a acoperi toata suprafata mainilor
- 2 Frecati mainile palma peste palma
- 3 Palma dreapta peste dosul palmei stangi cu impletirea degetelor si vice versa
- 4 Palma peste palma cu degetele impletite
- 5 Dosul degetelor pe palma opusa, cu degetele impreunate.
- 6 Frecri rotative cu degetul mare stang prins in palma dreapta si vice versa
- 7 Frecri rotative intr-un sens si celalalt cu degetele impreunate ale mainii dreapte, pe palma stanga si vice versa
- 8 Clatiti mainile cu apa
- 9 Uscati mainile cu un prosop de unica folosinta
- 10 Inchideti robinetului folosind un prosop
- 11 Odata uscate, procedura de spalare este terminata

Your 5 Moments for Hand Hygiene



1	BEFORE TOUCHING A PATIENT	WHEN?	Clean your hands before touching a patient when approaching him/her.
		WHY?	To protect the patient against harmful germs carried on your hands.
2	BEFORE CLEAN/ASEPTIC PROCEDURE	WHEN?	Clean your hands immediately before performing a clean/aseptic procedure.
		WHY?	To protect the patient against harmful germs, including the patient's own, from entering his/her body.
3	AFTER BODY FLUID EXPOSURE RISK	WHEN?	Clean your hands immediately after an exposure risk to body fluids (and after glove removal).
		WHY?	To protect yourself and the health-care environment from harmful patient germs.
4	AFTER TOUCHING A PATIENT	WHEN?	Clean your hands after touching a patient and her/his immediate surroundings, when leaving the patient's side.
		WHY?	To protect yourself and the health-care environment from harmful patient germs.
5	AFTER TOUCHING PATIENT SURROUNDINGS	WHEN?	Clean your hands after touching any object or furniture in the patient's immediate surroundings, when leaving – even if the patient has not been touched.
		WHY?	To protect yourself and the health-care environment from harmful patient germs.

2	Inainte de procedurile aseptice	Cand? Spala mainile imediat inainte de procedurile aseptice De ce? Pentru a proteja pacientul de intrarea in corpul sau a germenilor periculosi, inclusiv a celor de pe propria piele
3	Dupa riscul de expunere la lichide corporale	Cand? Spala imediat mainile dupa riscul de expunere la lichide corporale (iar apoi arunca manusile) De ce? Pentru protectia ta si a campului de tratament fata de germenii periculosi ai pacientului.
4	Dupa contactul cu pacientul	Cand? Spala mainile dupa contactul cu pacientul sau cu obiectele din preajma inainte sa parasesti perimetrul acestuia. De ce? Pentru protectia ta si a campului de tratament fata de germenii periculosi ai pacientului.
5	Dupa atingerea obiectelor din jurul pacientului	Cand? Spala mainile imediat dupa atingerea oricarui obiect sau mobilier aflat in apropierea pacientului, chiar daca pacientul insusi nu a fost atins. De ce? Pentru protectia ta si a campului de tratament fata de germenii periculosi ai pacientului
